- II. DELAC Norms and Overview:** DELAC Norms review and minutes approval.  
WHAT IS DELAC? District English Learner Advisory Committee made up of parents/guardians and staff with the intention to provide guidance and advice to the Principal and the staff with regard to the needs of students who are learning English as a second language.  
MAJOR FUNCTIONS OF DELAC: The committee advises and assists the school principal, staff as follows:  
The school's program for English learners.  
The school's needs assessment.  
The school's annual language census.  
Efforts to make parents aware of the importance of regular school attendance.
  
- III. New Business:**
  - A. Bilingual Schholar Program:** EL Specialists at each OFY School Site./iLit ELL Designated classes where students receive English credits or electives./ELD Intervention: EL students receive support with their Packets/Edmentum Online classes./English and Math Tutoring/Priority for enrolling in SGI class/Individualized Academic Learning Plan (ALP) created to meet the needs of the Bilingual Scholar student
  - B. ELPAC State Testing:**
    - It is an Annual State Test
    - The testing window is February 1st to May 31st, 2023



- There are four language domains: listening, reading, speaking, and writing.
- Student/Parent resources are on the ELPAC official website.
- Students need to get an overall score of 4 to be considered proficient in English.
- Students will test in person M-F by Appointment.
- Remote testing will be available as needed.
- Students and Staff will follow all standardized testing procedures.
- The test takes 2-3 hours and tests students for the following skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
- Students take breaks in between the domains and can take it in multiple days
- State Goal for completion: 95%
- Only English Learner Students take the ELPAC Summative
- California Dashboard: the most recent ELPAC data is from 2019

#### C. OFY Reclassification

- There are four requirements for students to be considered proficient in English:
- ELPAC score: An Overall Score of 4 is required
- Teacher evaluation,
- STAR REN Scores: based on grade level benchmark.
- Parent opinion and consultation
- RFEP DATA RESULTS:
  - 2019-2020 - 44%
  - 2020-2021 - 71%
  - 2021-2022 - 75%
  - 2022-2023 - ~80%

#### D. STAR REN TESTING

##### What is STAR Renaissance?

STAR Reading, STAR Early Literacy and STAR Math are standardized, computer-adaptive assessments created by Renaissance Learning designed to measure what students are learning in each grade and whether or not they are ready for the next grade. The goal



**is to ensure that all students receive what they need to be academically successful.**

**Students are expected to show growth from their previous administration.**

**E. School Plan for Student Achievement**

- **SPSA is developed with School Leadership & School Site Council (SSC)**
- **SSC has reviewed, provided feedback, and approved SPSA (approved on 12/14/22)**
- **SPSA must be aligned with school goals for improving student achievement**
- **Goals in SPSA are based on the Comprehensive Needs Assessment**
- **SPSA must be approved by the governing school board (scheduled for 1/24/23)**
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**EL Specific Actions:**

1. iLit curriculum will be an evidence based intervention used for instruction
2. Goal 3: English Language Arts Lexile Score
3. At least 20% of EL students will be reading at or above Lexile grade level band (baseline data: 14.56%)
