 - b. **LCAP Overview & Progress Update - Jessica Martinez** The LCAP is an academic plan developed by the charter to use targeted state and local funds to improve outcomes for low income, foster, and English Learner students subgroups, and to share their stories of how, what, and why programs and services are selected to meet their local needs. The plan needs to align with the 8 California State Priorities in order to be in compliance and to fully support all student subgroups. GOAL 1: Providing designated and specialized instruction for our Foster Youth, EL students, students with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, and socioeconomically disadvantaged pupils. GOAL 2: All students will have access to a Broad Course of Study to impact progress toward graduation and narrowing the opportunity gap. GOAL 3: Expose all students to College and Career Pathways in order to positively impact progress toward graduation and post-secondary readiness. GOAL 4: Cultivating a safe and healthy



learning environment and school climate to ensure that all stakeholders feel safe and a sense of connectedness to our school.

Academic Performance Evaluation Student's listening and speaking, reading and writing skills using a proficiency rubric Evaluation of authentic student work samples, especially writing samples Teacher evaluation, including, but not limited to, a review of the student's curriculum mastery 4. Parent consultation and opinion
