6. Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) Information and Transition Timeline

- SSC will be transitioning to a Parent Advisory Committee (PAC).
- Why? More meaningful engagement of parents, students, and educational partners.
- Some Requirements: the committee must include at least one parent who is low income, parent to an English learner, or foster youth.
- Q's: Can we add to PAC equity questions? Are we informing parents of meetings in a way that recognizes their input?
 - In May, LCAP survey provided an opportunity for feedback.
- PAC starts 7/1/23.
- Q'S: When is the next SPSA and LCAP due?
 - Due in mid May
 - Jessica will share SPSA, there will be time to review before meeting
 - Actions in SPSA are a result of funds
 - Discussion around SPSA will be focused around actions not money.
- Q's: Is the new data survey asking for the same actions from previous SPSA?
 - CNA data is considered for item actions.
 - CNA data is data and staff driven.
 - The CNA data from surveys is driving expenditure actions in SPSA.
 - LPAC survey data is used for LCAP actions to avoid supplanting.
