5. SPSA Goal Update on Metrics

- Current progress 33.35% for all students in pace to graduation, however we are making progress as the school year is beginning to wrap up.
- 42.86% homeless students are making progress in graduation.
- Average school progression 78.53 from school months 1-8.
- Want to increase the participation in CTE, College credit courses by the end of the 23/24 school year.
- A-G planning guide, expected outcome 18%, as of Feb 21.35%
- 2.75% of the 5% goal for all students completing a CTE course
- Identify and track our students career paths, as of right now, 6.05%
- Lexile growth 11.65% at/above grade level for EL students
